

TESTING PROCESS

PHYSICAL ABILITIES TEST: All final candidates selected from the interview must pass the City of Imperial Beach Lifeguard physical abilities test. The test will consist of a timed 500-meter swim in less than 10 minutes. *Passing the interview and physical abilities test does not guarantee your employment.*

APPLICATION SCREENING:

This recruitment will establish ONE eligibility list. The eligibility list will be effective for One (1) year.

THE CITY

Classic Southern California best describes the City of Imperial Beach. Imperial Beach, a community of 4.4 square miles, is located on the beautiful southern California coast adjacent to the cities of Coronado and San Diego. Imperial Beach has the distinction of being the "Most Southwesterly City" in the continental United States. The beach slopes into the Pacific Ocean, providing the perfect setting for recreational activities including cycling, swimming, surfing, and other water sports.

Imperial Beach was incorporated in 1956 as a general law City with the council/manager form of government.

THE POSITION

Under general supervision, maintain surveillance over an area of beach from an assigned station or patrol a section of beach in a vehicle in the protection of life, prevention of accidents, and enforcement of City ordinances. Detect and perform aquatic rescues and medical aid. Operate boats and all terrain vehicles. Perform search and recovery in the ocean and other waterways. Maintain safety equipment, facilities, and supplies within the Lifeguard Division. Prepare clear and concise records, reports, and logs. Subject to a 24-hour emergency call. Respond to emergencies when off duty and other work as assigned.

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: Applicants must be able to perform a wide range of physical duties. Occasional strenuous physical work requiring strength and endurance with exposure to environmental conditions of significant risk. There are periods of relative inaction, which still require alertness followed by high activity levels. Requires contact with the public under stressful conditions.



SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

The specialized and hazardous nature of life guarding requires that applicants demonstrate the ability to perform, or at least demonstrate the ability to acquire certain skill, knowledge and attitudes. General requirements at the time of application:

- ♦ Be at least 18 years of age.
- ♦ Completion of San Diego Regional Lifeguard Academy's *Introduction to Open Water Life Guarding* from Miramar Community College within the past two (2) years.

OR

- ♦ Worked 1,000 hours or more as a Beach Lifeguard within San Diego County.

AND

- ♦ Possess a valid class "C" California Driver License
- ♦ Possess a valid CPR for the "Professional Rescuer" or "Healthcare Provider" certificate.

AND EITHER

- ♦ Possess a valid American Red Cross *Emergency Response* Certificate.

OR

- ♦ Possess a valid San Diego County *Emergency Medical Technician B* Certificate.
