Group camping is available for programs who are traveling from a far distance. The group camping is \$10 per person a night. There is limited space, but we will try to accommodate as many programs as possible. Therefore, programs traveling the farthest distance will be given priority. Families shall arrange with the Junior Guard Program. Only one contact per program.

NOTE: This is a group area on the bayside of the park. You will need to carry your camping gear from the parking lot through the pedestrian tunnel. Vehicles are not allowed on the bayside.

Please contact John Anderson or submit form by July 15th. Once your group has confirmation, payment will be due before July 25, 2018, or by agreement with Silver Strand Lifeguard Association.

CAMPING RULES (BAYSIDE):

- **Check-In** at 12:00 p.m. unit 6:00 p.m. / **Check-Out** no later than 12:00 p.m. departure date.
- **TUNNELS** are for pedestrians and bicycles riders only; vehicles are not allowed to drive through the tunnels.
- **BAYSIDE** is for pedestrians and bicycles riders only. The service road on the bayside is for Maintenance, Lifeguard, and State Parks Peace Officers to provide service to the area.
- **CAMP AREA** is located on the bayside near tunnel #2. The area has fire rings, tables, ramadas and barbeque grills. There are restrooms located nearby. The camp area is designed for youth groups and leaders. This area is not for family camping (families need to organize with their program coordinator for reservations).
- **PARKING** vehicles will park in lot # 2 on the south end closest to LGHQ. Parking pass must be displayed.
- **DOGS** are not permitted on the Bayside or on the Beach.
- **EMERGENCIES** after the park is closed are handled by the Camp Host. They are in the campground (lot #4) right next to the kiosk. They are trained and will call the appropriate agency. Or call 911.

RV/Trailer Camping is available. The RV/Trailer camping is \$50 a night payable upon check-in at the campground.

Please contact John Anderson or submit form by July 20th. A confirmation letter will be emailed to you.

CAMPING RULES (RV / TRAILER):

Silver Strand Lifeguard Association reserved 10 spots in the campgrounds for RVs or Trailers that are self-contained. The gates are locked 9:00 p.m., therefore, there is no vehicle traffic into or out of the park. Please visit the parks website (https://www.parks.ca.gov/?page_id=654) to find more information on the rules. There are a few things to remember:

- **Check-In** after 2:00 p.m. / **Check-Out** no later than 12:00 p.m. departure date
- **VEHICLE RESTRICTIONS:** Fees include 1 registered, self-contained vehicle, plus 1 legally towed or towing vehicle per site. Towed vehicles must be verified by park staff as towed before they are unhitched, in order to be issued a complimentary pass. Permits for towed motor vehicles may not be switched to non-towed motor vehicles at any time during the stay. For an addition fee, each campsite is allowed 1 extra vehicle if it fits within the campsite. All vehicles must be parked fully within the limit lines of your campsite.
- **PETS:** Pets must be on a leash no longer then six feet and under the immediate control of a person. They are not allowed on the beach or bayside area of the park.
- **FIRES:** Beach fires must be in designated concrete fire rings only. Portable fire containers are not allowed on the beach or any other sand area. Camp stoves and fire containers shall be within the lines of your campsite and be elevated six inches or more above the pavement.
- **AMENITIES:** The park does have water and electrical hook ups at the camp sites. A dump station is available on the south end of the campground.
