ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION

Robert A. Moore and William J. Richardson hereby certify:

- They are the President and Secretary, respectively, of the WESTERN UNITED STATES LIFESAVING ASSOCIATION, a nonprofit California corporation.
- At a meeting of the BOARD OF DIRECTORS of the corporation, on February 22, 1989, the following amendment to the Articles of Incorporation was adopted.

Atticle I of the Articles of Incorporation reads: The name of this corporation is THE CALIFORNIA SURF LIFESAVING ASSOCIATION.

 The members of the Corporation having equal voting powers, approved the above amendment by 2/3 majority vote as required by the Bv-laws.

THE WESTERN UNITED STATES LIFESAVING ASSOCIATION

I

The name of this Corporation is THE WESTERN UNITED STATES LIFESAVING ASSOCIATION.

II

- A. This Corporation is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable purposes.
- B. The specific purpose of this corporation is to establish and maintain high standards of professional surf and open water lifesaving for the maximizing of public safety; to educate the public in water safety in a natural aquatic environment through a program of preventative awareness, and to actively support the general improvement of lifesaving and humanitarian causes.

III

The name and address in the State of California of this corporation's initial agent for service of process is Melvin Bowman, 103 Pacific Coast Highway, Huntington Beach, California, 92648.

IV

- A. This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
- B. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not be participating in or intervening in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office.

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to educational and charitable purposes, and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the

benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person. Upon the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for educational and charitable purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
